Dr. Förster is a senior policy analyst at the OECD and as head of the unit "Income Distribution, Inequality and Poverty" has been involved in successive OECD work on income distribution and poverty. He is a co-author of "Growing Unequal?" (2008) and lead author of the follow-up studies, "Divided we Stand: Why Inequality keeps rising" (2011) and "In It Together – Why Less Inequality Benefits All" (2015). Dr. Förster is currently directing several follow-up projects to this work, in particular on inter- and intergenerational income mobility and trends among middle-income classes. He is an author of various journal articles, research papers and book contributions, most recently to the Elsevier Handbook of Income Distribution.
